10 reasons why you should prefer the Southern French Alps in summer




$\stackrel{\scriptstyle }{\rightarrow}$ Dive in!

Swimming, rafting, canyoning, sailing or a siesta beside a stream: there's water everywhere, from the glaciers to the Massif des Écrins and the Durance or Verdon rivers. It gurgles away in the fountains and supplies a myriad of bodies of water. There are 26 main lakes – including the lagoon-coloured Lac de Sainte-Croix, the Lac d'Allos, the largest high mountain lake in Europe, and the inland sea of the Lac de Serre-Ponçon.



Wide open spaces, here we come!

Mountains, holm oak and larch trees as far as the eye can see - far from the madding crowd... the Southern French Alps cover 40% of the territory of the Région Sud and are home to only 8% of the population. Seven natural parks, including the Mercantour and Ecrins national parks and two UNESCO Geoparks, protect their natural beauty.



↓ Make friends

with a smile, whether they're camping on a campsite or in a camper van, in a bed & breakfast or a three-star hotel. The region has adopted the motto of its Villages d'Alpinisme: "Moins mais mieux" (less but better). Here, gentle and sustainable tourism respects the mountain world and the rhythm of nature.

tanding shoulder to shoulder with the beautiful Southern Alps, the hills of Haute-Provence, rising 700 to 1,200 metres above sea level, pan out in the sunshine under a comfy forest blanket. Trees cover 70% of the 500,000 acres comprising the Baronnies Provençales Regional Nature Reserve. Orpierre and its cliffs offer a thrilling adventure playground for climbing enthusiasts from the world over. Guarding the gateway to this magnificent area, the citadel of Sisteron stands on the Napoleon Road and "Route du Temps" heritage trail leading to Digne-les- Bains. Dotted with geological treasures, the trail offers stunning views over Lure mountain, a herbalist's paradise.

THERMAL SPA AT THE THERMES O DIGNE-LES-BAINS

Good news for holidaymakers visiting the Alpes-de-Haute-Provence resorts and especially Blanche Serre-Ponçon area: the "Thermes de Digne-les-Bains" has just opened a superb new thermal spa. Set on the first floor, with uninterrupted vistas over the valley of springs, its large outdoor and indoor pools proffer the benefits of highly-mineralized waters springing from the foot of the cliff at temperatures of between 22 and 42°C. A tribute to the great explorer Alexandra David-Neel, who retired to this corner of the Alpes-de-Haute-Provence, the treatment menu features, among others, a Tibetan Kansu Bowl massage.


HALTE AIR & GO ECO-LODGES MARCOUX

ORPIERRE REACHING FOR THE STARS ORPIERRE

Nestling in Céans valley, Orpierre (Goldstone) wears its name well: its treasures are the cliffs that surround it, criss-crossed with nearly 600 climbing routes. You can even see the climbers progressing upwards from the streets of this little village in the Baronnies Provençales Regional Nature Reserve. The local stores buy and sell climbing gear, and the local professionals love sharing their passion and expertise. The village has also thought of climbers' children and created a series of educational trails for tiny tots in the nearby forest of Beynaves...

GAP CHAMPSAUR VALGAUDEMAR DÉVOLUY

he town of **Gap** – the administrative capital of the Hautes-Alpes area – is steeped in the atmosphere of the Southern Alps. Along the ancient Napoleon road, the bluish horizons of Provence give way to breathtaking scenery and Europe's highest bocage adds an extra green touch to **Champsaur** valley. **Valgaudemar**, on the other side of the valley's emblematic **Chaillol** mount, is France's most Himalayan valley, while **Pic de Bure**, the region's largest astronomical observatory, gazes out over the striking mineral formations of the Massif du **Dévoluy**.

♥ MOUNTAINEERING VILLAGES **OF ÉCRINS**

Born and bred in Marseille, and a militant photographer and street artist since 2014, Philippe Echaroux projects giant portraits and messages on town walls and out in nature. His work on the Amazon rainforest hoisted him to worldwide fame. From June to September, 15 of Philippe's astonishing portraits of local inhabitants will be adorning Écrins National Park's seven mountaineering villages (Pelvoux-Vallouise, Valgaudemar, Monêtier-les-Bains, Villard'Arêne, La Grave, La Chapelle-en-Valgaudemar and Valjouffrey), projected onto various media including walls, houses and trees. The works produce a minimal amount of light and do not impact local fauna.

HAUTES-ALPES WHITE TRUFFLE **•** HAUTES-ALPES

After 20 years of research, the Robin nursery in Saint-Laurent-du-Cros, has finally succeeded in mastering the white truffle (tuber magnatum) growing cycle. This truffle, hitherto only found in Italy, is rare, expensive, and difficult to grow. Mycorrhization of oak roots was performed in partnership with the National Research Institute for Agriculture, Food and the Environment (Inrae). This family business founded in 1948 is now a leader in controlled mycorrhization. The nursery has already sold 2,500 young oaks carrying the coveted mycorrhiza, grown in the neighbouring Alpes-de-Haute-Provence area.


VIA SOUTERRATA IN LE DÉVOLUY: TWO IN ONE! • LE DÉVOLUY

Inaugurated in 2017, the first "Trous de la Tune" via souterrata route has met with massive success. This underground via ferrata, which adventurers can explore kitted out with a harness, hard hat, lanyards and a headlamp, is unique in Europe. Located fifteen minutes on foot from Superdévoluy, it is free and accessible 24/24 in all seasons, although we definitely recommend opting for a caving guide if it's your first time. A new, 45 minutes "Cathédrale" route now extends on from the original "Chatière".

SERRE-PONÇON EMBRUNAIS UBAYE

ailing, windsurfing, rafting or a spa break? Basking to the South of the Hautes-Alpes area, **Serre-Ponçon lake** resembles a small inland sea, dedicated to the joys of boating and bathing. **Embrun**, nicknamed the "Little Nice of the Alps", stares down at the lake from the top of its rock. **Ubaye** valley's natural legacy remains untarnished despite its turbulent past, offering a virgin paradise for hiking, skiing and white water sports. In the 19th century, a mad migratory story unfolded in this magical valley, still visible today in the shape of **Barcelonnette**'s Mexican-style villas.

HOSPITALITY

HOUSEBOATS ♀ LAC DE SERRE-PONÇON

Moored in the intimate bay of Foreston, these gorgeous houseboats ("toues cabanées") dressed in wood offer a uniquely relaxing experience on the water. Measuring 25m² and beautifully furnished, they feature five berths, a master cabin, living room with single berth and sofa, well-equipped galley and garden furniture ideal for a plancha feast or soothing siesta. The boats are solar powered and fitted with paddles, and an electric craft whisks you out to your floating home. Breakfast is delivered or served on land at the Paillote du Lac, a waterfront restaurant inviting you to lounge back in your personal deckchair and contemplate the surroundings peaks. You'll find water sports gear and outdoor games there too. €667 for two nights from June 17th to September 11th.

Measuring 30m² and incorporating a mezzanine, the chalets welcome 4 guests and are fitted with a living room complete with pellet stove, kitchen and bathroom. Situated one kilometre from Barcelonnette, the four "Jungle Lodge" hanging tents and chalets are perched behind the "Jungle Parc" adventure course. Accommodating 4 to 6 guests, they are surrounded by large nets resembling spider's webs, inviting adventurers to get up close and personal with the Austrian pine trees. Tree hugging and barefoot hikes are on the menu too, together with juniper and Scots pine essential oil distilling demonstrations. 



ook up and breathe in! Set at the gateway to the ski resorts of **Montgenèvre** and **Serre-Chevalier, Briançon** is surrounded, in the words of Vauban, "with valleys that descend into the abyss and mountains that touch the clouds". The latest French summits conquered by mountaineers, **La Meije** and La **Barre des Ecrins** tease the stars, while the great mountain passes of **Galibier** and Lautaret spur on sporting feats. At the gateway to **Ecrins** National Park, the **Queyras** Regional Nature Reserve – a haven of stone pines, larches and traditional craftsmen – shines like an island in the ocean of the Southern Alps...







Objective: to unite around a common brand, "Alpes du Sud" ("Southern French Alpes" internationally), a common strategy and budgets to be stronger and more visible to markets and customers. After working around the values of the brand, a "Southern French Alpes" Brand Contract was sealed. Since its launch in January 2018, the Southern French Alpes brand has been co-managed by the Provence-Alpes-Côte d'Azur Regional Tourism Board and the Hautes-Alpes Development Agency. They were joined in 2021 by the Nice Côte d'Azur Metropolitan Area. Most of the resorts in Alpes-de-Haute-Provence, Hautes-Alpes and Alpes-Maritimes take part in the promotion/communication actions offered, aimed at the general public, the media and tour operators.
